### **Herring Run Relief Sewer Project**

This Baltimore County Department of Public Works project involves construction of approximately 11,000 feet of a relief sewer along Herring Run from the City Line

to Aiken Avenue, construction of 58 manholes and 900 feet of tunnel under Perring Parkway. This project is necessary to eliminate pollution that is entering the Herring Run and alleviate sewer backups impacting homes in Harford Park. Work includes clearing and grubbing vegetation, relocation of 200 feet of water main, traffic control, trench excavation, trench repair within Oakleigh Road, Darlington Drive, Queen Anne Drive and Taylor Avenue, and landscaping and tree planting at the completion of the project. Currently, DPW is preparing tunnel crossings under Perring Parkway and at Taylor Avenue.

HPCA is in contact with DPW regarding this project and will continue to provide updates. Dave Bayer from DPW is available to answer questions and can be reached at 410-887-3781.

### **Water Infrastructure Project**

Harford Park is also in the midst of an upgrade to its potable water infrastructure. The first stage of the project is the replacement of the main lines which is almost completed. The next stage will tie in the individual houses to the main lines. As main lines are completed, they will be chlorinated to kill pathogens, flushed, and tested, before connecting to homes. Each homeowner will be notified by letter when their connection will occur as service will be briefly disrupted.

### **2020 Presidential Election**

Election Day is Tuesday, November 3, 2020. This year's General Election in Maryland will offer in-person and mail-in voting with early voting options. Covid-19 pandemic restrictions and concerns about gathering in large groups have made these options necessary. To register to vote, verify your information on file, request a mail-in ballot, or find your polling place, go to <https://elections.maryland.gov/>. You can call the Board of Elections at 800-222-8683. If you request a mail-in ballot, it will be mailed to the address on your voter registration. Early voting in-person will be available from October 26th through November 2nd from 7am to 8pm.

## Dumpster Day – Saturday September 12<sup>th</sup> from 8am till noon

### *By the pool on Queen Anne Drive*

**DUMPSTER RESTRICTIONS:** Any waste not generated in Harford Park, electronics, refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, appliances with Freon, controlled hazardous substances or liquids (pesticides, acids, chemicals), explosive materials, flammable materials or liquids (propane tanks, gasoline, kerosene etc.), medical or radioactive waste, septic or sewage waste, liquids or liquid waste (paint, oil, antifreeze, etc.), automobiles/parts, animal carcasses, drums or tanks, tree stumps over 12 inches in height and over 36 inches across the roots, tree branches or wood over 8x8 inches by 6 feet long (including railroad ties), concrete curb and concrete gutter, steel slabs and iron, reinforcing bars and steel rods, wire spools and steel cable, concrete and stone greater than 18 inches in size, tires of any type, boats, campers, pickup truck caps, asbestos materials/shingles, batteries (vehicle/marine).
