- \* 80 Million to continue to recover from Covid, to spend 60 million equity recovery and save 20 million for later

- \* Special session will be called and will redraw congressional lines every 10 year, week of December 6th
- \* Delegates will be putting forth a bond bill of \$100,000 to bring our building up to code for ADA, new roof and other upgrades

Herring Run Relief Sewer and Water Main Replacement project update. - \* Project is expected to be done in late 2022, Park restoration included, issues with people driving through the park because of the openness of the park, creighton has some left over construction debris
- \* We need to reach out to traffic and engineers to try to put up a fence to block traffic from people going through.
- \* Windsor Road Resident, tunnel going under road from Taylor, when will the tunnel be done and pile of soil and stone
- \* Contractor has been having issues and county is not happy, they are a 3rd of the way done
  - \* They will use the dirt and stones when they fill in the holes
- \* There will be no more blasting, only digging
- \* When will dead ends resurface be done, it will have to be after winter because of asphalt

Current balance and membership total - Baltimore County COVID-19 Nonprofit Recovery Grant funding received and currently being used for upgrades to the Community Hall and technology upgrades.

- \* Membership is at 87
- \* Beginning balance as of 5/1/21 \$8,805.83
- \* Ending balance as of 7/31/21 \$25,216.34
- \*Our balance is inflated because we haven't spent all of our money on the improvements from the grant, the increase of money was because of the grant we received from Baltimore County for building upgrades

\* We are still working at this but are waiting on 1 more signature to move forward, letter has been sent certified
